## Being Part of UCC Students' Union

UCC Students' Union is run by an executive, which reports to Student Council. This March, 5 full-time officers and 7 part-time officers will be elected to the Students' Union Executive.

The full-time officers will take a year out of their studies, or will work for a year if they're in final year. Part-time officers will carry out their positions while completing their studies.

All officers work for the benefit of all UCC students through their positions. They sit on committees in the University, organise events & campaigns and work on various projects.

## Core Responsibilities

- Electing and Organising class reps for every class and year in the College of Arts, Celtic Studies and Social Sciences
- Helping organise training for class reps
- Organising Class Clinics, where class reps meet to discuss issues and motions before council, or specifically regarding the college.
- Ensuring the Maximum number of Class reps turn up to class council

## Other Responsibilities

- Helping class reps on a case by case basis with issues that arise through the year, such as timetable clash, exam issues and referrals onto other officers.
- Promoting engagement with the SU as a part time officer, both with class reps and the general student populace.
- Actively supporting SU endeavours as much as is possible as a part time officer.
